Ray asked us to write to you with our comments about conditions at the start at Paignton Regatta.

The start boat was not anchored. It was positioned on the start line by the boat driver for each race and he did this very well. However this did give us some problems.

Between races the boat was allowed to drift off the start line. If there was a large gap between races the boat moved some distance, up to 50 metres from the start line. This must have been very confusing for the competitors as they expected the start boat to be on the line and could not understand why when they were asked to move up onto the start line they had to keep rowing as the start boat was moving.

The buoys used to mark the start line were not very big and the one closest to the shore and further from the boat was a white buoy with a black flag; at times it was difficult to spot against the shore especially as it was not necessarily in line with the boat and the nearer buoy.

If the crews were drifting over the start line the boat driver crept up alongside the crews. Again he did this very skilfully but having lost the transit of the buoys, one could not be sure that the line of crews was still at 90° to the course.

The boat moving during the start procedure was very confusing for the start umpires. When you are watching the crews and getting them lined up, you are not aware that the boat is moving very slowly, just that you have lost the transit.

The boat engine was running all the time, so it was difficult to hear what crews were saying.

We understand that the boat owner is reluctant to anchor his boat and we have no complaints about his boat handling skills. Ideally the boat should be anchored fore and aft to ensure that it does not off the start line.

Having said all that. It is a very nice boat and we greatly appreciated having a toilet and tea-making facilities. In fact for the first half of the regatta we had a lovely "tea lady" (the owner's wife) on board.
