THIS WAS A POTENTIALLY SERIOUS INCIDENT INVOLVING NOT ONLY THE SCULLER BUT THOSE INVOLVED IN THE RESCUE.

IT WAS ESTABLISHED THAT THIS SORT OF INCIDENT HAD HAPPENED AT PREVIOUS EVENTS TO THE SAME SCULLER.

THE SCULLER WAS TRANSFERRED FROM HER BOAT INTO THE UMPIRES RIB AND TAKEN TO THE SHORE LINE.

ST JOHN AMBULANCE ATTENDED MS LAWSON IN THE RIB UNTIL IT WAS DEEMED SAFE TO ASSIST/WIFT HER OUT OF THE BOAT. SHE WAS CARRIED TO THE BEACH AND WAS PLACED SEMI CONSCIOUS IN THE RECOVERY POSITION.

ST JOHN AMBULANCE ADMINISTERED OXYGEN AND MONITORED MS LAWSON FOR A CONSIDERABLE TIME (45 MINS+)

SENIOR UMPIRE ADVISED BLURS CAPTAIN N. PENNINGTON TO DISCUSS STATE OF HEALTH WITH MS LAWSON'S PARENTS AND CONSIDER BEST ACTION TO AVOID RECCORRANCE. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THIS INCIDENT IS REPORTED TO WATER SAFETY COMMITTEE AND BRITISH ROWING FOR COMMENT/ACTION
